

The 4th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest in Guiyang, China

On September 28, the Komaru-Koutsu Foundation (Administrative Director: Shigehiro Komaru, President and CEO of Fukuyama Transporting Co., Ltd.; hereinafter referred to as the “Komaru-Koutsu Foundation”) held the 4th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest at Guizhou University in cooperation with the Consulate-General of Japan in Chongqing, Hiroshima University, and Guizhou University.
