

The 3rd Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest in the Republic of Indonesia

On October 20, the Komaru-Koutsu Foundation (Administrative Director: Noriyuki Komaru, Chairman and CEO of Fukuyama Transporting Co., Ltd.; hereinafter referred to as the “Komaru-Koutsu Foundation”) held the 3rd Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest at Darma Persada University in Jakarta, Indonesia in cooperation with Hiroshima University and Darma Persada University.

The contest has been held in Jakarta since 2016, and this was the third time. The contest received 105 applicants under the theme of “transportation,” among which 10 outstanding candidates delivered their speeches.
