

The 7th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest in the Republic of Indonesia

On December 10, the 7th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest was held for the first time in three years at the Darma Persada University (Republic of Indonesia) in cooperation with Hiroshima University PERSADA-HU Collaboration Project Center and Darma Persada University in the presence of Mr. Kenji Kanasugi, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Embassy of Japan in Indonesia as a guest of honor.

The contest received 59 applicants from 10 universities under the theme of “transportation,” among which 10 candidates selected by screening process delivered their speeches. The grand prize was awarded to Mr. Muhammad Aziz Mazaya from the University of Indonesia, who gave the following speech: “We must reconsider driving by the elderly to protect the lives of our precious ones.”
