

The 5th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest in Shanghai, China

On September 15, the Komaru-Koutsu Foundation (Administrative Director: Noriyuki Komaru, Chairman and CEO of Fukuyama Transporting Co., Ltd.; hereinafter referred to as the “Komaru-Koutsu Foundation”) held the 5th Japanese Language Composition Speech Contest by Chinese speakers at Shanghai International Studies University in Shanghai, China in cooperation with Hiroshima University and Shanghai International Studies University.

The contest has been held in Shanghai since 2014, and this was the fifth time. The contest received 189 applicants under the theme of “transportation,” among which 8 outstanding candidates delivered their speeches. The grand prize was awarded to Ms. Hao Hao from Jiangsu University, who was commended by Managing and Administrative Director Shigehiro Komaru of the Komaru-Koutsu Foundation.
